

**NOTE:** The WSTV1 can support screen sizes up to a maximum of 60" diagonal.


























### Dimensions - TV Interface







### **Supplied Parts and Hardware**

Vertical Height Adjustment Bracket








#### **STEP 1 Attach TV Brackets to TV**

#### 1.1 Select TV Screw Diameter

Hand thread screws into the threaded inserts on the back of your TV to determine which screw diameter (M4, M6, or M8) to use.






#### 1.2 Select TV Screw Length

If your TV has a flat back AND you want your TV closer to the swivel head of the mount, use the shorter screws.

Spacers and longer screws are supplied to accommodate:

- Round/irregular back TVs
- TVs with inset mounting holes
- Extra space needed for cables




Standard configurations are shown. For special applications, or if you are uncertain about your hardware selection, contact Customer Service at 1-800-359-5520.

#### A CAUTION:

Verify adequate thread engagement with your screw/ washer/spacer combination AND TV bracket.


- Too short will not hold the TV.
- Too long will damage the TV.



#### 1.3 Attach Horizontal Brackets

Position your TV brackets over your TV hole pattern - making sure the brackets are centered over the TV hole pattern and level. Secure brackets using your screw/washer (**Flat Back**) or spacer/screw/washer (**Round Back / Extra Space**) selection (see 1.2 page 7).

**IMPORTANT**: Ensure TV brackets are securely fastened before moving on to the next step.




### **STEP 2 Attach Vertical Bracket**

Make sure the vertical height adjustment bracket 14 is centered on the TV.

Secure vertical height adjustment bracket 14 with interface screws 15.


**IMPORTANT**: Ensure all brackets are securely fastened before moving on to the next step.




### **STEP 3 Attach Neck to Base**

Attach neck 16 to base 17 with nuts 19. Start by hand tightening the nuts 19 then complete the tightening by using supplied wrench 18.

(IMPORTANT: Ensure neck 16 is securely fastened to base 17 before moving on to the next step.







### **STEP 4 Swivel Head to Neck**

**STEP 5 Attach TV to Swivel Head** 


- 1. Hang swivel head 20 onto neck 16.
- 2. Secure with two lock screws 21.






### **STEP 5 Attach TV to Swivel Head (continued)**


- 1. Determine the height from the base that you would like to hang your TV (see examples Page 11).
- 2. Secure the TV/bracket assembly to the swivel head **20** with the two lock screws **21**.
  - **IMPORTANT**: Keep the base clear while installing TV.
  - **(I) IMPORTANT**: Ensure TV/bracket assembly is securely fastened to swivel head **20** before moving on to the next step.






### **Cable Management**

Remove the cable cover **cc**. Route cables down the cable channel of the neck and through the opening in the base of the neck. Replace the cable cover **cc**.






### Adjustments


Post install leveling can be adjusted  $\pm$  1.5 degrees using the adjustment screw (AS) in the swivel head 20.

±1.5° Clockwise ±1.5° Counterclockwise

TV can be swiveled ±20° (40° total) for best viewing angle.



TV can be tilted back 5° for a better viewing angle or to compensate for deflection caused by a heavy TV. To adjust tilt, loosen both lock screws 21, adjust tilt, then tighten both lock screws 21.





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
